

Loose Cat Dangers

CLIP OUT SHAPE
TO HANG
ON DOORKNOB

- Danger of being hit by a moving vehicle and killed or critically injured
 - Danger of being stolen for use by dogfighters or to be sold to labs for experiments
 - Danger of consuming something poisonous or inedible
 - Danger of suffering an attack by wildlife, especially small breeds (coyote, snakebite, javelina, owls, etc.)
 - Danger of being picked up by animal control – could incur fines and fees to retrieve, possibly euthanized if not retrieved in time
 - Danger of picking up parasites, fleas, ticks and other vermin from adjacent properties or open fields
 - Danger of being attacked by dogs, other cats – acquiring deadly diseases transmitted by cat bite
 - Danger of being harmed by individuals – poisoned, sexually abused, burned, maimed, beaten
 - Danger of losing their way home after chasing animals or wandering away from home/familiar scents
 - Danger of becoming impregnated or impregnating other loose cats, and add to stray cat population, resulting in more cats being euthanized*
- * It is very important to spay and neuter ALL your pets to control the pet population and prevent unwanted litters that will end up being killed in our county shelters.
